



TEMPORARY DRESS CODE & RULES

Gentlemen are not required to wear a jacket in any of the public areas.

Ladies are required to wear conventional smart business dress, which includes smart trouser suit, skirt or dress.

Short-sleeved full button-fronted shirts or smart polo shirts are acceptable.

Smart jeans, provided they are not ripped, stained, soiled or stonewashed, are allowed in the Courtyard.

Sportswear, vest tops, leggings (including jeggings), casual zipped or leather jackets, sweatshirts, fleeces and trainers are not permitted.

Please keep all outerwear, such as overcoats, hats and scarves, as well as bags with you at your table while the Cloakroom is closed.

Mobile phones and all digital communication devices must be on silent and may only be used for verbal communication in the mobile phone booths in the Sports Area or outside of the Club. Verbal communication via any electronic digital device is not permitted in the public areas. Non-verbal digital communication is permitted throughout the Club.

Laptops, business papers and tablets may be used in the public areas for presentation purposes.

Members looking for well earned refreshments after using the sports area can expect a warm welcome into the Courtyard and enjoy a relaxed area of tables (subject to availability) where sports attire is acceptable.
